**General Rules and Regulations**  
for all Professional Circle Buskers

Busking at the Saskatoon Fringe Theatre Festival is defined as a person who entertains passers-by, while asking for money. Only verbal suggestion of the value of the performance is permitted.

In consideration of being granted a license to use the specified space of the Saskatoon Fringe Theatre Festival the undersigned (Licensee) agrees to all terms and conditions.

1. All Licensees, their agents, affiliates, and invitees are subject to these General Rules and Regulations.
2. Liability:
  - a. The Licensee agrees that it will indemnify and hold harmless 25<sup>th</sup> Street Theatre Centre of, from, and against all claims, demands, actions, damages, loss, costs, liabilities, expenses, and judgments incurred by, recovered from, or imposed on 25<sup>th</sup> Street Theatre Centre in account of injury or damage to persons or property caused either proximately or remotely, wholly or in part, by the negligence or wilful misconduct of the licensee, or of its agents, servants, patrons, or guests.
  - b. The licensee agrees that all property (including cash) which the licensee has on the premises is the responsibility of the licensee and is in its care, custody, and/or control.
3. The Licensee expressly covenants and agrees to obey all Municipal, Provincial, and Federal Statutes, Bylaws, and Regulations and to obtain such necessary permits, licenses, or other authorizations as may be required by Federal, Provincial, and Municipal regulations.
4. **Busking licenses are not transferable.**
5. The Licensee agrees to observe all parking regulations which may be in effect, the direction of parking attendants and security personnel, and other such regulations that may be in place on, and surrounding the Fringe Festival site.
6. The Licensee agrees to maintain clean premises and that all refuse/waste will be placed in the designated bins in that area.
7. The Licensee agrees that 25<sup>th</sup> Street Theatre is not responsible for the safety and security of all **items left in the provided storage** area and that all items will be removed by 11 pm Sat Aug 9, 2008.
8. Use of fire must be discussed with 25th Street Theatre Centre prior to any performance.
9. **Buskers using fire must have on hand** a Class 2A10BC fire extinguisher, a fire blanket, and an assistant prepared to use them, if needed.
10. **Undue noise or unseemly methods** of demonstrations employed while operating will not be tolerated. The decision of what constitutes undue noise or unseemly methods shall rest with 25th Street Theatre Centre whose decision will be final.
11. 25th Street Theatre Centre reserves the right to cancel this agreement at any time if, in its opinion, the terms and conditions are not being observed.
12. The licensee agrees to abide by all regulations and rules adopted by 25th Street Theatre Centre in the best interest of the festival and agrees that 25<sup>th</sup> Street Theatre Centre management shall have the final decision in adopting any rule or regulation deemed necessary prior to, during, and after the festival.
13. 25th Street Theatre Centre is committed to maintaining the accuracy, confidentiality, and security of your personal information. It is our policy not to give or sell any information that personally identifies you without your consent.
