**General Rules and Regulations**  
for all Curbside Buskers

Busking at the Saskatoon Fringe Theatre Festival is defined as a person who entertains passers-by, while asking for money. This includes music, comic, and other performances or the offering of hand-made crafts or art on display in small quantities. **All transactions must be by donation only and no prices may be posted.** Verbal suggestion of the value of the performance or item is permitted.

In consideration of being granted a license to use the specified space of the Saskatoon Fringe Theatre Festival the undersigned (Licensee) agrees to all terms, conditions, and covenants.

1. All Licensees, their agents, affiliates, and invitees are subject to these General Rules and Regulations.
2. Liability:
  - a. The Licensee agrees that it will indemnify and hold harmless 25<sup>th</sup> Street Theatre Centre of, from, and against all claims, demands, actions, damages, loss, costs, liabilities, expenses, and judgments incurred by, recovered from, or imposed on 25<sup>th</sup> Street Theatre Centre in account of injury or damage to persons or property caused either proximately or remotely, wholly or in part, by the negligence or wilful misconduct of the licensee, or of its agents, servants, patrons, or guests.
  - b. The licensee agrees that **all property (including cash) which the licensee has on the premises is the responsibility of the licensee** and is in its care, custody, and/or control.
3. The Licensee expressly covenants and agrees to obey all Municipal, Provincial, and Federal Statutes, Bylaws, and Regulations and to obtain such necessary permits, licenses, or other authorizations as may be required by Federal, Provincial, and Municipal regulations.
4. **Busking licenses are not transferable.**
5. The Licensee agrees to **observe all parking regulations** which may be in effect, the direction of parking attendants and security personnel, and other such regulations that may be in place on, and surrounding the Fringe Festival site.
6. 25th Street Theatre Centre reserves the right to cancel this agreement at any time if, in its opinion, the terms and conditions are not being observed.
7. 25th Street Theatre Centre reserves the right to relocate or alter the space assigned to the licensee.
8. All **refuse/waste must be placed in the designated bins** in that area.
9. No structures may be erected and the licensee must be able to **remove all materials from Broadway Avenue without the use of a vehicle**. No materials may be left on site outside of festival hours.
10. No tobacco or smoking related products or paraphernalia are permitted to be sold at the festival.
11. **Undue noise or unseemly methods** of demonstrations employed while operating will not be tolerated. Sound levels of radios and all other sound amplification equipment must not interfere with other licensees or event patrons.
12. The decision of what constitutes undue noise or unseemly methods shall rest with 25th Street Theatre Centre whose decision will be final.
13. The licensee agrees to abide by all regulations and rules, including **hours of operation**, adopted by 25th Street Theatre Centre in the best interest of the festival and agrees that 25<sup>th</sup> Street Theatre Centre management shall have the final decision in adopting any rule or regulation deemed necessary prior to, during, and after the festival.
14. 25th Street Theatre Centre is committed to maintaining the accuracy, confidentiality, and security of your personal information. It is our policy not to give or sell any information that personally identifies you without your consent.
